### 'The Work of Faith'

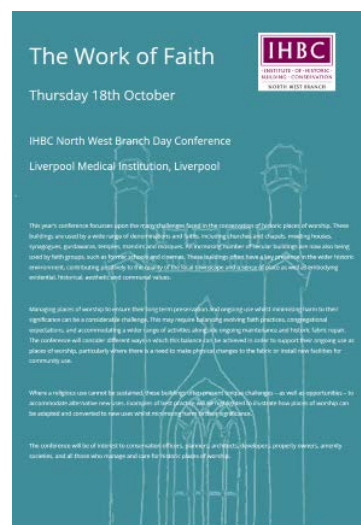
